DAY 1 - ARRIVE DELHI (D)

On arrival transfer to Hotel Clarks Inn in the Pacific Mall. Afternoon city tour of Old & New Delhi, the Old City, Red Fort, Jain temple & Jain Bird hospital. Raj Ghat- the memorial of Mahatma Gandhi & Shanti Van; walk along Chandni Chowk, the silver street of Delhi bustling with activity. Visit India Gate, Bahai temple, Lakshmi Narayan, a Hindu temple, Bangla Sahib Gurdwara, a Sikh temple. Drive past Presidents house, Parliament house, Government secretariat buildings & Connaught place, the heart of New Delhi a busy shopping center.

DAY 2 - DELHI - AGRA (B D)

Depart for Agra. Check in at the Hotel Howard Park Plaza. Agra, the quintessential Mughal City, where the world marvels at The Taj-Mahal one of the wonders of the world, an overwhelming magical monument. As you walk down the narrow bustling streets, you can not help but wonder, if the man contentedly smoking a hookah, is a direct descendent of some bygone Mughal. Afternoon city tour visiting the Taj Mahal & Agra Fort.

DAY 3 - AGRA - FATEHPUR - PUSHKAR (B D)

Depart for Pushkar enroute view local villages experiencing their daily life. Visit Ghost city of Fatehpur Sikri, the red sandstone city of yester years, built in AD 1564. Visit major attractions of this city. Continue to Pushkar enroute viewing local villages. Check in at the Hotel Pushkar Palace.

DAY 04 - PUSHKAR JAIPUR (B D)

Visit some holy temples, like Brahma Temple, Gau Ghat, Nag Hill, Markendeya Rishi Ashram, Pap Mochini Temple, Agastya Muni Ashram, Gaya Kund & beside the picturesque lake, the Savitri Temple & browse in the Pushkar Bazaar for antiques, jewellery etc. Depart to Jaipur, check in at Hotel Ramada Plaza. Jaipur, The picturesque capital of Rajasthan. This Beautiful city along with

Agra & Delhi form what is known as the Golden Triangle, where royalty lives in the grandeur of its palaces, where treating guests as kings has been a tradition. A timeless appeal to Jaipur's colorful bazaars to shop for Rajasthani hand looms & trinkets. Beautifully laid out gardens & parks, attractive monuments & marvelous heritage hotels, once the residence of Maharajas. Not to mention the ambling camels & cheerful people in multi-hued costumes that make your trip to the pink city a memorable one. Early dinner at the hotel. Later visit Chocki Dhani, an ethnic Rajasthani Cultural village, to see cultural dancing, & browse for shopping.

DAY 5 - IN JAIPUR (B D)

Visit Amber Fort, ancient capital of the State until 1728. Visit Temple of Kali, Hall of Victory or Jai Mahal & Jagmandir. Have the unique experience of traveling on elephant back to the fort. City tour visiting City palace & explore the colorful lanes of the pink city's bazaars & visit to the solar observatory. Drive past Hawa Mahal or Palace of Winds.

DAY 6 - BY AIR - JAIPUR - MUMBAI (B D)

Transfer to airport for flight to Mumbai Transfer to Hotel Ramee Guestline Juhu. Lured by its glamour & the prospects of 'streets paved with gold', large numbers of people from different parts of the country come to settle in Mumbai. Mumbai continues to grow, to absorb, to prosper. Just when you begin to wonder how you're ever going to cope with Mumbai, you arrive at Worli & see Haji Ali Mosque standing proudly on a raised walkway in the middle of the sea. At night, there is a backdrop of twinkling lights from the skyscrapers. The scenes change as you drive past Chowpatty Beach, ablaze with lights of stalls selling fruit-juice, ice-cream & snacks to the crowds thronging the beach, & sedate charming horse-drawn landaus. Once a tiny island overrun by swaying palm trees, Mumbai used to belong to native Koli fisher-folk,

who still live here in their little villages surrounded by soaring skyscrapers. Portuguese arrived in the seventeenth century & dotted the place with several forts. Afternoon & evening at leisure or to shop.

DAY 7 - IN MUMBAI (B D)

Morning motor launch excursion to Elephanta caves. Half day city tour visiting historical sites, contemporary wonders, archaeological sites, religious sites & natural wonders. The Gateway of India the main attraction & a must see during your Mumbai sightseeing. Drive along Marine Drive & Juhu. Visit the tranquil Hanging Garden & the Kamla Nehru Garden. The Chowpatty gives you a view of the well known beach of Mumbai.

DAY 8 - DEPART MUMBAI - DUBAI (B D)

Transfer to airport for flight to Dubai. On arrival transfer to the Ibis City Hotel or similar. Afternoon at leisure. Evening traditional Dhow cruise & dinner. Enjoy a panoramic cruise on the serene waters of Dubai Creek Indian Ocean, Cruising past impressive sights experiencing the romantic side of Dubai.

DAY 9 - DUBAI (B)

Start your tour with a photo stop on the beach giving you magnificent views of the world famous BurjAl Arab hotel. Continue to Jumeirah Mosque, a grand mosque & head towards the Palaces of the Sheikhs of this emirate & the Dubai creek, for photo shoots. Pass by Al Bastakiya old-wind tower houses, built by the wealthy merchants. Next on to historical Al FahidiFort, converted into the Dubai Museum. The Museum is the 200 year-old restored Palace of Sheikh Saeed. Visit the Abrastation & take an Abra (water ferry) to cross the creek, We pass through bustling alleys towards the spice & gold souks. Afternoon & evening at leisure or to shop.

DAY 10 - DUBAI (B)

Depart to the airport for your onward flight.
